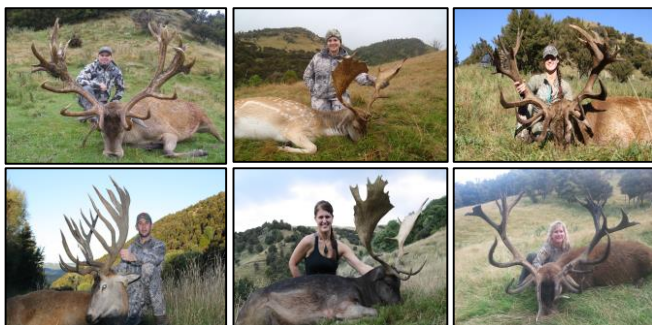




Kaweka Hunting Newsletter- March 2014

A further 5 river systems are in close proximity to the lodge and also provide great trout fishing. We recently had a couple of hunters shoot their stags early on in the week and they decided to spend the day down at the Mohaka where they had a very enjoyable day's fishing.



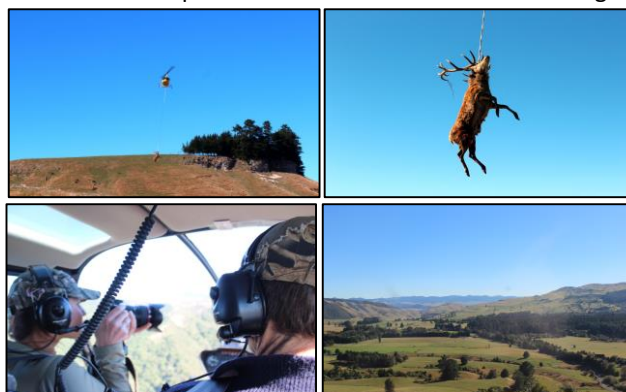
Lodge Expansion
